Instructions:

Each morning and evening read the Scripture passages assigned for the day. Do this every day, morning and evening. You may choose to read the morning passage privately, for personal devotion, or with your family. Whenever possible read the passage aloud so you may hear God's Word, and process the words audibly.

The evening passage is to be read with others – your spouse, a friend or family -- at the close of the evening meal, or before you retire at night. If possible, read the passage at the dinner table with friends or family.

Follow the steps below for each reading:

1. *Pray.* Ask God to give you ears to hear. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal and guide you into truth.
2. *Read and Listen.* Have one person read the passage out loud, slowly and clearly. Take turns reading. Always read the passage out loud. All other family members should listen, not read along, and receive the word in silence.
 - a. The reader should begin by stating, "Hear God's Word from..." citing the reference for the reading.
 - b. Read the passage through.
 - c. Do not comment or teach on the passage.
 - d. Do not read a study Bible or paraphrase version.
 - e. Simply read God's Word out loud, slowly and clearly.
 - f. When the passage is complete the reader should say, "This is God's Word." Friends or family members may respond by saying, "Thanks be to God."
 - g. All remain silent for a few moments to receive what has been heard.
3. *Pray.* Conclude with prayer. Thank God for His Word; for how He is teaching us to listen, and for how He is leading our church into the discovery of His will.
